- 1. - 2. Roller skating or Bowling event for Spring: still working on getting in touch with locations for dates and pricing.
- 3. Field Day will be June 2, 2023 with a rain date of June 10th. Have been in touch with Kona Ice truck since allergen friendly to provide for students and staff. Also looking into unchartered wild as an assembly for the day. Other assembly ideas are red cross, DARE, various first responders. Kelly talked about having boxed lunches from the cafeteria as an option for students if we wanted to have them eat lunch outside. Lori is working on t-shirts which will be provided for students and teachers can buy them at cost. We will have a google form sent home to parents to get sizing for each child for t-shirts. We will need to replenish our supplies for the games and there was talk of purchasing a karaoke machine to use for this and other PTSA events.
- 4. Courtyard clean up... we need to see if there is interest in forming a group to help clean that up. There is \$250 in our budget to put towards doing this.

- 5. BEEP, Christy Fortin: enrollment has ended and parents are currently being notified of which class their child is in. The program will start 3/1 and run through 3/30.
- 6. Color Run: still looking at doing this in May for the secondary school. Kim and Lori have attended a webinar on this to see how other schools did it. It looks like we will need about 15 volunteers to put on the event.
- 7. Bingo night: possibly rescheduling for March or April based on other school events happening.
- 8. Snack Monster: Kim reached out to Amy Labshire and the key club students about helping to make this for us.
- 9. Krause's Candy Fundraiser: orders are due 2/16 from students and we have to submit to Krause's by 2/28.
